The nominations for CIPS Innovation Awards 2024 are solicited from government agencies, PSUs, NGOs, private organisations and individuals for the innovations implemented in the border districts, Union Territories, North-Eastern and Hills States of India.

CIPS was established in 2010 based on the recommendations of Thirteenth Finance Commission, to create a climate for accelerating and diffusing innovations in public systems through sharing of experiences across states.

CIPS has been recognizing innovations through the "CIPS Innovation Awards Scheme", and has awarded 18 innovations across the Union Territories, Northeastern and Hill States in Education, Environment, Health, Information Technology, and Rural Development, categories in the year 2023. A publication "Celebrating Inclusive Innovations in the Northeastern & Hill States and Union Territories", showcasing the innovations of these awardees was released in January 2024 by Sri Conrad K Sangma, Hon'ble Chief Minister of Meghalaya.

Purpose of awards: CIPS is dedicated to providing a platform for the emergence and cross-fertilization of innovative ideas by identifying, recognizing, promoting, and replicating innovations in public systems. It is therefore expected that by honoring best innovative practices, a hospitable environment will be created by scouting, sustaining, and spawning new innovations that would result in bringing positive changes in culture as well as structure of governance across states.
